Covid 19 - update on outdoor sports 13th May 2020

The Government have announced that some restrictions on some sports may be lifted from 13th May 2020, lawn bowls is one of the sports concerned.

Individuals may meet with one other person to take part in their sport providing social distancing guidelines are maintained. The Management Committee have agreed that our club will be open for play under these restrictions. A maximum of two members may share a rink whilst still maintaining social distancing guidelines.

A booking system will be in place to allow individuals to book a rink for one hour sessions.

Shared equipment such as jacks and mats should be sanitised before and during play. The club does not hold a stock of sanitiser so members will be required to provide their own. I hope to attend the hut tomorrow to arrange rink notifications and provide rink booking forms.
